- Cost: All float Trips \$450.00 for one or two anglers.
- Fee based on an 8-hour day, dock to dock.

What to Bring

- All gear including rods, reels, flies and terminal tackle will be provided (excluding waders).
- If you would like to bring your own gear, your guide will advise you on what you should bring for that specific trip. Please refer to our gear guides below.
- Please pack your own lunch. Due to legal restrictions, we cannot serve lunch to our patrons. Guides will provide a cooler with ice and water only.

General Information About Float Trips

- Various vessels can be used depending on the water. Float trips are for a maximum of two anglers due to watercraft capacities.
- Life vests are provided for adults over 18. Life vests are not provided for anyone under 18 and it is required to bring your own of the proper size.
- Your guide will contact you within 72-48 hours of your scheduled trip date.
- Be sure to check local weather and communicate with your guide about your trip. You are responsible for wearing appropriate clothing for cold, sun or rain protection.
- No alcohol is permitted on all trips by law.
- All trips are strictly catch and release.
